## **Purpose of Meeting:**

- To review the UIP template and discuss Charter Renewal

## **Agenda items:**

1. **Addendum to Agenda:** After discussion with Jen Martin, YMCA scholars will be escorted from Enrichment classes by a Wyatt Teacher to the Great Hall.
2. **Review meeting norms** (Daly)
3. **Vote on previous meeting's minutes** (Daly)- Motion made by M.McKinsey, seconded by Jen Martin.
4. **Charter Renewal/Discussion of Strategic Action Plan** (Daly/Taylor)

Joe Taylor reviewed the overarching goals for our school to meet expectations on the School Performance Framework: PARCC, ELD and NWEA MAP (Reading and Math) as well as STAR. Wyatt scholars will meet or exceed similar schools average % Strong or Distinguished Command, as well as ambitious growth targets by the end of the school year. The DPS Portfolio Management Team will attend the next CSC meeting. Note: the Positive Culture Family Involvement Action Plan/ Improvement strategy stems directly from feedback given from family survey.

5. **UIP Template** (Daly/Taylor) **Note: First draft due on 9/26, uploaded by October 28, 2015.** Lauren Daly explained the purpose of and the reasoning for the Unified Improvement Plan. Joe Taylor will explain our intervention goals and submit a completed academic plan.. The CSC committee will approve or ask for more information on the school's improvement plan.

**6. Regarding charter renewal:** (Joe Taylor) Wyatt has met every benchmark set by DPS and are in full compliance with those goals. The final piece of the renewal process is the PARCC goal, for which the data will not be available late November, with the Charter Renewal process to take place in December. DPS has noted that they will move the “School Choice” to January to accommodate this. Joe is advocating that Wyatt be given more time to analyze data in fairness to our families. Joe is working with the Portfolio Management Team to extend the PARCC goal for a second year for data comparison before the decision is made to not renew our charter. Joe is making the case that the changes created by the administration are the changes that DPS would have made if Wyatt were a turn-around school. Wyatt has a strong, well-funded Charter Board that has supported Rigorous Curriculum Design and other changes. In addition we helped unite our community through community events after losing several members to violence. Joe encouraged families on the CSC to attend the October 15, November 19, and December 7, DPS School Board meetings and talk in front of the Board to support Wyatt, as well as recruit parents to come and speak.
